Brotherhood of Scouting (purple patch in center). Note: the ring around the purple patch was a special patch given out in the 100th year or Scouting.

Patch earned later; don't buy now

Arrow of Light and "God 'n Me" (only if your scout earned it as a Webelo/Cub Scout)

Round Council Patch Rank (none initially; scout will earn ranks and be given them at Court of Honor)

Epaulets (Ask scout store about color—green or red ok)



Patrol Patch (will be given later) American Flag (comes presewn) Chief Seattle Council shoulder patch (see note below)



Troop Numbers 6 4 7

Positional and trained patch (later)

8. AND: GET A BOY SCOUT HANDBOOK (recommended: spiral bound...it's a few \$ more but lasts longer). The Handbook has a depiction on the inside covers front and back on the uniform and patches.

Other notes: no neckerchiefs in Troop 647. Scout pants are optional, as is a scout belt and socks. Some scouts like the neat appearance. Neat pants or shorts are required for special events (Board of review, Court of Honor, etc).

A Note about attaching the badges and other uniform item: "Badge Magic" is available at the scout store. It's basically glue on a contact sheet. It's easy BUT it leaves a nasty mess/residue. Sewing is much neater looking; Badge Magic is easier....you decide.
